how to create your own basket\*

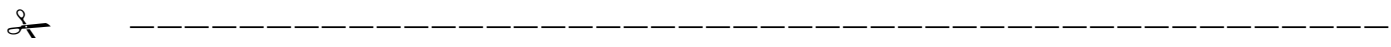
